### Summary

This qualification provides students with legal entry, comprehensive knowledge and confidence to work with young children in the early childhood sector. Students will be exposed to both classroom and workplace training, ensuring you will gain the skills to have a rewarding career within this field.

### Structure

This is a 52-week qualification, taught in-class with additional vocational placement. Students will be required to attend 2 days of formal lectures (9am - 3pm) and 1 day of class-based self-paced study per week. The qualification is comprised of competency-based training and assessment - no exams! Students will be required to log a minimum of 160 hours of vocational placement, with EIM International securing this placement on the students behalf.

### Support

Students will be provided with resources, assessment tools, organisation policies and procedures and reference resources. Trainers are available by appointment for one-on-one mentoring if required. EIM also boasts a strong student hub and student services department.

### Eligibility

Students must have passed equivalent Australian Year 11 qualifications, and hold an overall IELTS 5.5 average, or equivalent language level.
