SUMMARY

This qualification provides students with the required accreditation, knowledge, and confidence to work with young children in the early childhood education sector. Combining classroom learning with hands-on workplace training, it equips students with the skills needed for a rewarding career. Upon completing all required units, students will receive a Nationally Recognised Qualification under the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) and an official certificate.

STRUCTURE

This 17-month qualification is offered in both class-based and workplace-based formats. Class-based students attend two days per week (9am–3pm) with additional self-paced study, while workplace-based students complete assessments on the job. The course follows a competency-based training and assessment model, requiring a minimum of 160 hours in a regulated education and care service. EIM Training will arrange the vocational placement.

SUPPORT

Students will receive learning materials, assessment tools, organisational policies, procedures, and references. Class-based students can access one-on-one mentoring if needed, while workplace-based students will have monthly trainer visits for training and assessment, with extra support available by appointment.

ELIGIBILITY
