CAREER START AND CAREER BOOST TRAINEESHIP/APPRENTICESHIP PATHWAY: FEES, CHARGES AND REFUNDS (2025–2028)

SCOPE

This Fees, Charges and Refunds document has been developed in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Trade, Employment and Training (DTET) and the Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) 2025.

This document applies to all training and assessment activities and services provided under the Career Start and Career Boost funding arrangements for EIM Training.

Student Contribution Fees

In accordance with Queensland Government training policy 2025–2028, EIM Training is required to collect a co-contribution fee. This fee is calculated at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency delivered.

The total fee will vary according to the total nominal hours of the units selected within each traineeship or apprenticeship qualification.

Concessions (Partial Exemptions)

A reduced co-contribution fee of no more than 40% of the standard rate (i.e. \$0.64 per nominal hour) applies where a student is eligible under the following concession categories:

- The student is under the age of 17 at the end of February in the year in which EIM Training delivers the training, is not at school, and has not completed Year 12.
- The student or their dependent/partner holds a Commonwealth-issued Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card.
- The student provides an official form under Commonwealth law verifying eligibility for concession.
- The student identifies as being of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent.

Fee Exemptions

Full exemptions from the co-contribution fee apply in the following cases:

- The student is undertaking the qualification as part of the Skilling Queenslanders for Work
 - Work Skills Traineeship Program.
- The student is a school-based apprentice or trainee.
- The student is awarded a credit transfer for a unit of competency.
- The student experiences extreme financial hardship, subject to documented approval.

Eligibility and Enrolment Information

EIM Training can provide preliminary guidance on funding eligibility under Career Start and Career Boost and available course options.
